

ANALGESIC POST TEST (SAMPLE)

Our analgesic post test is administered to our study subjects after they have been educated on protocol mandated analgesic assessments. The post-test is detailed and we spend a significant amount of time going over the correct and incorrect answers to ensure the patient has no significant cognitive gaps. Below is an example of one of the vignettes on our patient post test.

SCENARIO 1:

Categorical Scale Assessment:

During recovery after surgical procedure, patient **Sally** tells the study staff that "she is having a lot of pain". She reports her pain level to be **7** out of 10 (0 = no pain and 10 = worst pain imaginable). She records on the pain intensity and categorical scale assessment as follows:
